## Figure 4.17e - Viewpoint 10: Sgurr a' Choire Ghlais.

This viewpoint is located approximately 14km Northwest of Cannich.

PLEASE NOTE - Access to this viewpoint location involves travelling along Glen Strathfarrer which is part of a private estate. At certain times of the year the road is closed to motor vehicles. It is strongly advised that you check if vehicular access is available before visiting site otherwise it is an 8 miles walk along the road to the base of the climb up Sgurr a' Choire Ghlais.

From Drumnadrochit take the A831 west towards Cannich. At the t-junction in Cannich, turn right following signs for the A831 to Beauly. Stay on the A831 until you reach Struy. At Struy, cross over the humped river bridge and then take the turn on your left signed to Glen Strathfarrar turning sharply back on yourself. Follow this road for 12 kilometres until to pass the shores of Loch Beannacharan. Continue past the Loch towards the western end and you will pass a cottage. Keep going and pass Deanie Power Station on your right. After approximately 900 metres and just before you reach the shores of the next loch (Loch a'Mhuillidh) look out for the track heading off up to the right. Pull off the tarmac road and park here. Now on foot, start to head up the track.

From this point on it is strongly recommended that the user sources designated mapping for this walk. There are several websites detailing walks to the summit of Sgurr a' Choire Ghlais.

The camera location is at the summit next to the trig point.
