Kirkan Wind Farm Limited (company registration number **09172025**) 22-24 King Street, Maidenhead, Berkshire, SL6 1EF, is seeking, under Section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989, consent to construct and operate a wind farm within Strathvaich Estate in the Highlands (Central Grid Reference 236293, 867462).

The installed capacity of the proposed generating station would be in excess of 50 MW comprising 17 turbines with a height to blade tip of up to 175 metres.

Kirkan Wind Farm Limited is also applying for a direction under Section 57(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 that planning permission for the development be deemed to be granted.


