


Figure 4.15e - Viewpoint 8: Summit of Sgurr a’Muillin.



Grid Reference: 226469 855746      Distance to nearest turbine: 14840m      AOD: 877m

This viewpoint is located approximately 11km southeast of Achnasheen.

Travelling from Inverness on the A835 towards Ullapool, you will approach Contin. Pass through Contin still on the A835 and cross the bridge over the river. You will then approach a right hand bend. Just on this bend there is a small turning off left signposted to Loch Achilty. Turn left here.

Continue on this minor road that will take you around the north edge of Loch Achilty and eventually on towards the Luichart hydro power station. Just after the power station turn left under the electricity pylons and continue on until you reach the head of Loch Meig and the dam. Cross over the dam and turn right at the t-junction. Stay on this minor road for approximately 9km during which you will pass through the hamlets of Porin and Milton, eventually coming to a small burn crossing and some wooden-clad cottages. As you reach the cottages there is a stone walled animal enclosure on your right. Immediately after the roadside stone wall there is a small patch of rough ground on the right. Park here.

From this point on it is strongly recommended that the user sources designated mapping for this walk. There are several websites detailing walks to the summit of Sgurr a’Muillin.

The camera location is on the summit at the stone cairn.
