Thank you for your consultation which we received on 01 November 2019. We have considered it and its accompanying Supplementary Environmental Information (SEI) in our role as a consultee under the terms of the above regulations and for our historic environment remit. Our remit is world heritage sites, scheduled monuments and their setting, category A-listed buildings and their setting, and gardens and designed landscapes (GDLs) and battlefields in their respective inventories.

Our Advice

We have reviewed the additional information received in relation to the hydrological and peat assessments as well as supplementary landscape assessments.
